** Agenda Item: Jeremy Croteau – ANR – Hollow Rd.

The board looks over the maps with Jeremy Croteau, looking at both parcels abutting a qualified way, that both parcels have the correct amount of frontage of 150 feet.

Hugh B. gives the Planning Board an overview of what Conservation has observed at the property, Conservation felt as though there were inconsistencies within the maps vs. what the actual land shows. Conservation has many concerns regarding the Tree Cutting Plan, subsequently the Commission imposed an enforcement order on the property effective 7/19/21. This order refers to activities that took place outside of the defined work area of the Forest Cutting Plan for this property. Although the board would have liked to have seen the wetlands on the property reflected in the plans, the board feels that the splitting of this property complies with what is required by the State and local zoning laws. A majority of the board members signed the ANR for 40 Hollow Rd.
