Steps we have taken to create the Official Map for the Town of Wales

- 1. Read every town report since 1762 to identify town roads
- 2. Obtained road lists from Town Clerk and Road Commissioner
- 3. Submitted Town Warrant article 26 for the May 21, 2014 Town Meeting
  - 1. Town took no action
- 4. February 2016- held public hearing and requested presence of Park Commission, Road Commissioner, and David Worth
  - 1. received suggestions, heard concerns, and determined that we would not have time to prepare a warrant article before the deadline
- 5. March 2016- Consulted with Pioneer Valley Planning Council's GIS manager regarding map
  - 1. instructed to include and distinguish on map:

all parks and playgrounds; public ways (including state roads and highways); private ways and shared access drives, unaccepted roads, paper streets in approved plans

- 6. Consulted with Wales Board of Assessors regarding which paper roads to include from the Assessor's Maps
- 7. 2016 Town Warrant
  - 1. article 23 officially change MA DOT designation of Stafford Road to two distinct streets: Stafford-Holland and New City Roads- Adopted
  - 2. article 24 accept as town ways both Old Hollow and Old Country Roads- Adopted
  - 3. article 25 accept the new measurements of both Ol Stafford and Shaw Roads-Adopted
- 8. 2016- Road Commissioner measured distances of all town roads
- 9. Found no documentation that Hegan Street had ever been voted on to be town road
  - 1. Planning board or Road Commissioner will present an article on the 2017 Town Warrant
- 10. January 23, 2017, second public hearing
- 11. Prepare an article requesting approval of the Official Map and its attributes for the 2017 Town Warrant
