## Meeting of Monday, March 22, 2021 Regular Session

## **CHAIRMAN'S ANNOUNCEMENT**

"Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §18, and the Governor's March 15, 2020 Order imposing strict limitation on the number of people that may gather in one place, this meeting of the Wales Board of Selectmen is being conducted in-person and via remote participation. No inperson attendance of members of the public will be permitted, but every effort will be made to ensure that the public can adequately access the proceedings in real time. In the event that we are unable to do so, despite best efforts, we will post on the Town of Wales website an audio or video recording, transcript, or other comprehensive record of proceedings as soon as possible after the meeting."

#### **OPEN & PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

The Vice Chairman called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. leading the room in the Pledge of Allegiance.

## FY2022 BUDGET – JOINT MEETING WITH FINANCE COMMITTEE

Ms. Leduc indicated further updates would be added upon submissions from the Highway Department, Tax Collector and School for teacher's COLA per their contracts. Ms. Leduc is keeping a master record of budgets from all Departments. For initial review purposes, some departments have level funding placeholders.

The Finance Committee indicated they were still meeting with departments and do not have employee salary adjustments nor the final health insurance impacts until the review process is finalized.

Schools - Tantasqua's assessments are: \$875,884 and \$33,284 (Transportation). Mr. Valanzola indicated the Tantasqua assessment reflected an 11% increase based on student enrollment shift. The Elementary School's budget went to Public Hearing and was voted upon at \$1,926,389.

Timeline: Documents sent to printer by April 4<sup>th</sup>.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

### Inspector of Animals Nomination

Motion:

Mr. Grasso moved, seconded by Mr. Valanzola, to nominate Gary Wilson as Inspector of Animals for the Town of Wales for the year ending April 30, 2022, in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 129, § 15, as amended.

## • Non-Partisan Caucus

Mr. Valanzola questioned why a caucus would be canceled. He indicated candidates would be able to secure their required signatures at a caucus rather than going door to door as was done last year because of Covid concerns. With just 10 signatures required on nomination forms, the Town Clerk felt it was not an undo retractor for candidates. The Town Clerk plans to contact incumbents and will distribute nomination papers

as requested by the public. For space and safety (health) concerns, the Town Clerk recommended that the 2021 Annual Town Non-Partisan Caucus be eliminated.

#### Motion:

Mr. Grasso moved, seconded by Mr. Valanzola, to eliminate the April 14, 2021 Annual Town Non-Partisan Caucus pursuant to Section 3 of Chapter 5 of the Acts of 2021 and to direct the Town Clerk to provide nomination papers to anyone seeking office at the May 26, 2021 Town Election.

VOTE: All in Favor

## • Hampden County Regional Retirement Board

The Board discussed the recent audit for the Hampden County Regional Retirement System (HCRR). The audit reflected a negative review and reports of inappropriate financial actions.

Action: Mr. Valanzola recommended the Board review the HCRR audit (on-line) before taking any action.

## • Update – Public Employees Committee (PEC)

Ms. Leduc indicated all PEC members were advised the 30 day negotiation period ends April 21<sup>st</sup>. She asked that the Board provide some available dates to meet and negotiate with the PEC.
