

Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 4:40 PM.

Meeting Minutes:

Debrief from Olde Home Day 2021: Museum opening was a success. Everyone pitched in for cleaning, getting painting and other maintenance items, including install of two mini-split units complete. Binders are to return to the Library for safekeeping and to be accessible to the public in the Historical Room Collection.

Final details that need to be resolved are the quilt racks (arriving next week) and Tantasqua Electrical doing a few repairs.

NEW BUSINESS

Funding opportunities: Group is not interested in lectures and presentations this year. In the future, perhaps we could team up with the Cemetery Commission for cemetery preservation workshops or other related preservation events. The Cultural Council applications are again open, deadline of October 15th. The Chair may submit for a grant. Discussed items such as storage cabinets for the museum.

Donations: The Commission has been approached by Bill Anair, who may consider donating an oversize historic "music box" that would need an enclosure of possibly 4 feet by 4 feet by 6 feet tall (to be determined).

Gatehouse: The Highway Dept has been looking to relocate the Lake George Gatehouse that was removed from the dam that is sitting in the Highway yard. Becky would like to have it moved back to the dam area, as close to its original location as possible.

Decorations: Group would like to setup the outdoor Christmas decorations like last year – wreaths and candles in the windows. There is not a significant Halloween presence in town this year, but perhaps next year.

MOTION: To adjourn made at 5:39pm. Motion made by Chrabascz, seconded by Smith. All in favor, Motion Passed.
